**MEMORANDUM GRANTING LEAVE TO FILE EVIDENCE LATE**

**Hearing Stream 2**

1. The Hearing Panel, on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2017, received a request seeking leave for expert evidence to be accepted, from CentrePort Limited (Submission #121) and from CentrePort Properties Limited (Submission #141).
2. Mr Beatson, Counsel for CentrePort Limited and CentrePort Properties Limited, advised that Mr Daysh, expert panning witness for CentrePort Limited and CentrePort Properties Limited would be on leave during Hearing Stream2 and was not available for any of the scheduled hearing dates for that Hearing Stream. As such, Mr Beatson sought leave for another planner to adopt Mr Daysh's evidence and be questioned by the Panel; or for Mr Daysh's evidence to be accepted and that any questions from the Panel, be raised and responded to in writing. This later alternative being that preferred by the submitters.
3. The Panel agree that having received the filed the evidence from Mr Daysh, that any questions arising, if there are any, would be best put to Mr Daysh.
4. The requested leave to accept the evidence from Mr Daysh is granted. Should the Panel have any questions arising from Mr Daysh's evidence, then those will be put in writing to Mr Daysh along with a timeframe for Mr Daysh's written response to the Panel.
