1. This memorandum seeks leave to extend the date for filing expert evidence for Wellington International Airport Limited (**WIAL**) for Hearing Stream 5.
2. WIAL is intending to lodge, and present at the hearing, three statements of evidence from Mr John Kyle, Mr David Thompson and Mr Matthew Palliser.
3. WIAL has been unable to finalise its evidence today, in part due to Otago Anniversary Day (which is today), and accordingly WIAL respectfully seeks leave to file its evidence by 5pm Tuesday 27 March 2018.
4. It is respectfully submitted that this is only a very short extension and should allow more than sufficient time for the evidence to be considered by the Panel, the Council and other submitters before the hearings commence on 9 April 2019.
