MEMORANDUM GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME FOR MR LOE'S RIGHT OF REPLY

Hearing Streams 5 and 6

1. The Hearing Panel, on Monday, 16 July 2018, received a request seeking leave to an extension of time in which to file Mr Loe's Right of Reply Reports for Hearing Streams 5 and 6, from Greater Wellington Regional Council (GWRC).
2. The reason for the request in the delay in filing Mr Loe's Right of Reply Reports for Hearing Streams 5 and 6, is that Mr Loe has suffered a bereavement and is not in a position to complete the reports.
3. The memorandum from Counsel for GWRC, sought to update the Panel on when the reports might be available on 20 July 2018, once Council has had the opportunity to discuss the matter with Mr Loe.
4. The Right of Reply topic reports being prepared by Mr Loe are Discharges to Land (Hearing Stream 5) and Contaminated Land/Community Drinking Water Supplies (Hearing Stream 6).
5. The Panel grants the request. No submitters are considered to be affected by the extension. In addition, the dates for filing the remainder of Right of Reply Reports for Hearing Streams 5 and 6, remain unchanged.
6. The Right of Reply Reports from Mr Loe will be due a later time, to be determined by the Panel. Council is requested to update the Panel as to a possible timeframe by 5pm on Friday, 20 July 2018. In addition, any other Right of Reply Reports for Hearing Stream 5 and 6 remain due on 16 July 2018 and 18 July 2018, respectively.
