However, where avoidance of an archaeological site is not possible, an Archaeological Authority will be required. An Authority is also required if there is reasonable cause to suspect that an archaeological site may be modified or destroyed. Part 3 of the HNZPTA sets out the requirements for protecting archaeological sites and applying for authorities to modify or destroy such sites.
