1. Wellington Water Limited (**WWL**) wishes to be a party to the following appeal of decisions on the Proposed Natural Resources Plan for the Wellington Region:

Hutt City Council v Wellington Regional Council, ENV-2019-WLG-000120


2. WWL is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991.
3. WWL agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
4. WWL is interested in the part of the proceedings related to:

Definition of 'regionally significant infrastructure'

5. WWL supports the relief sought in relation to this part, for the reasons set out in Hutt City Council's appeal.
6. WWL is interested in the part of the proceedings related to:

Policies for discharges to air from landfills

7. WWL supports the relief sought in relation to this part. The relief sought will provide for regionally significant infrastructure in a practicable way. WWL supports alternate relief that provides for an approach based on 'best practicable option'.
8. WWL made submissions on the definition of regionally significant infrastructure, and submissions to make better provision for regionally significant infrastructure throughout the Plan; and has an interest in the parts of the proceedings identified in this notice that is greater than the interest that the general public has, to the extent that those parts are about the way in which the Plan addresses regionally significant infrastructure.
