

Notice of Wellington Water Limited's wish to be party to proceedings

1. Wellington Water Limited (**WWL**) wishes to be a party to the following appeal of decisions on the Proposed Natural Resources Plan for the Wellington Region:

**Wellington City Council v Wellington Regional Council, ENV-2019-
WLG-000119**

2. WWL is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991.
3. WWL agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
4. WWL is interested in the part of the proceedings related to:

**P102 (Reclamation or drainage of the beds of lakes and rivers)
and/or the definition of "regionally significant infrastructure"**

5. WWL supports the relief sought on this part to the extent that it allows for inclusion of landfills as regionally significant infrastructure.
6. WWL supports the relief sought because landfills are a necessary aspect of the wastewater treatment process and hence it is appropriate for landfills to be defined as regionally significant infrastructure.
7. WWL made submissions on the definition of Regionally Significant Infrastructure and policy P102, and has an interest in the proceedings that is greater than the interest that the general public has, because the proceedings relate to provisions that affect wastewater infrastructure and services, for which WWL is responsible.



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
