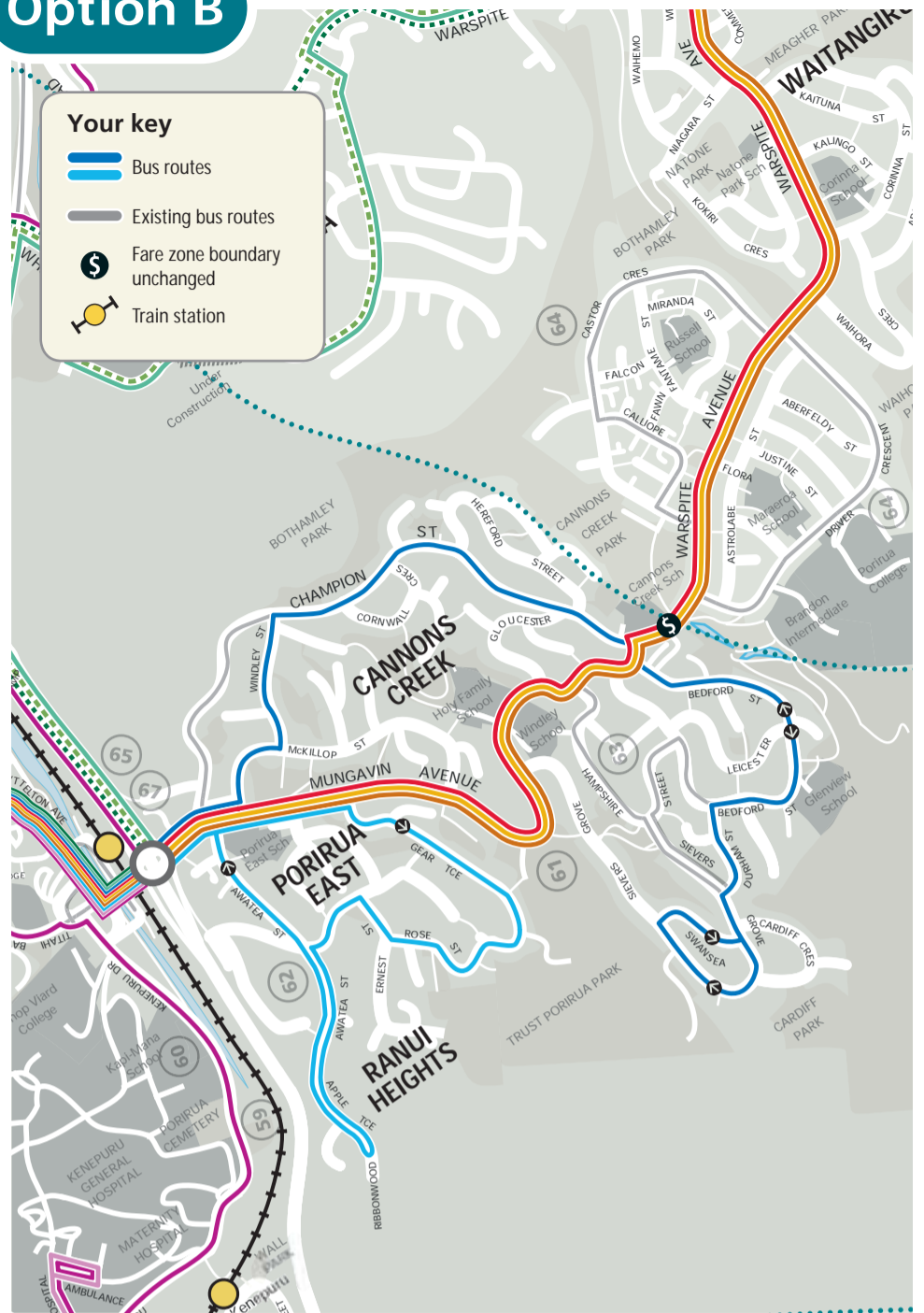
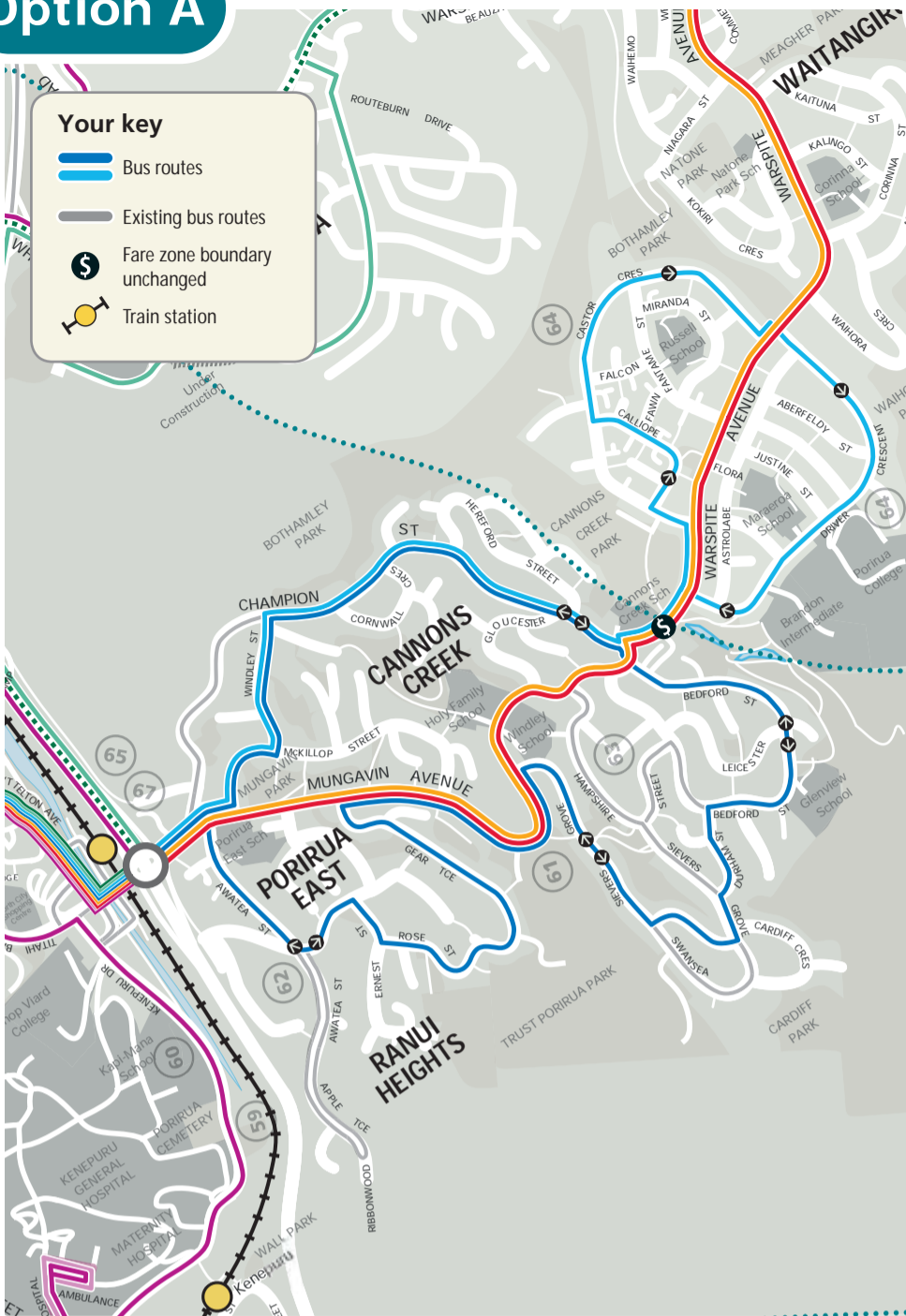

Porirua East

Current

Porirua East is serviced by Route 62 to Ranui Heights, Route 63 to Sievers Grove and Route 64 to Castor Crescent. Porirua East is also serviced by Route 61 to Ascot Park. Existing routes need to change as they carry few people and are expensive to run.

Option A

Retains Route 64 to Castor Crescent and replaces Route 62 and 63 with a two-way loop via Champion Street, Sievers Grove and Gear Terrace. Some of the roads used would also change. There would no longer be a service to Apple Terrace.

Option B

Retains Route 62 to Ranui Heights and changes some of the roads used by Route 63. Removes Route 64 to Castor Crescent to enable longer hours of operation on the other routes and to enable Route 61 to continue through the Porirua city centre and on to Titahi Bay.
