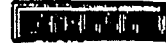

~~Where a council to which section 101H of this Act applies makes a resolution under that section, that council shall forthwith upon making that resolution,—~~

- (a) Send a copy of that resolution to—
- (i) The Commission; and
 - (ii) The Surveyor-General; and
 - (iii) The Government Statistician; and
- (b) ~~In the case of a resolution made by a regional council, send a copy of that resolution to every territorial authority whose part of whose district is within the region; and~~
- (c) In the case of a resolution made by a territorial authority, send a copy of that resolution to any regional council for a region in which the district or any part of the district of the territorial authority is situated.
