<i>(1) Discussion of options for development of a new Johnsonville Bus/Rail interchange</i>	<i>The information contained in this report relates to options available to Greater Wellington for the development of a new Johnsonville rail/bus interchange. Discussion with the developer and other parties are still to take place. Having this part of the meeting open to the public would disadvantage the Greater Wellington in commercial negotiations.</i>	<i>That the public conduct of the whole or the relevant part of the proceedings of the meeting would be likely to result in the disclosure of information for which good reason for withholding would exist under sections 7(2)(c) and 7(2)(i) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (i.e. to protect information which is subject to an obligation of confidence which, if released, would be likely prejudice the supply of similar information and its in the public interest that such information should continue to be supplied, and to enable Greater Wellington to carry on without prejudice or disadvantage negotiations).</i>

(2) *Review of passenger transport fare levels*      *The information contained in this report relates to the annual review of passenger transport fare levels. The report discusses contracts which Greater Wellington holds with transport providers in the region. Having this part of the meeting open to the public would disadvantage Greater Wellington's commercial negotiations. Greater Wellington has not been able to identify a public interest favouring disclosure of this particular information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override this prejudice.*      *That the public conduct of the whole or the relevant part of the proceedings of the meeting would be likely to result in the disclosure of information for which good reason for withholding would exist under section 7(2)(i) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (i.e to enable Greater Wellington to carry on without prejudice or disadvantage negotiations).*

(3) *Services operated by Community Coach Services*      *The information contained in this report relates to the future of services operated by Community Coach Services. Release of the report would disadvantage Greater Wellington as it would reveal information that could harm commercial negotiations. Greater Wellington has not been able to identify a public interest favouring disclosure of this particular information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override this prejudice.*      *That the public conduct of the whole or the relevant part of the proceedings of the meeting would be likely to result in the disclosure of information for which good reason for withholding would exist under section 7(2)(i) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (i.e to enable Greater Wellington to carry on without prejudice or disadvantage negotiations).*
