

Power of Attorney to sign Deeds

This is a Power of Attorney by way of a Deed signed by two elected councillors of the Wellington Regional Council, a council under the Local Government Act 2002 on the _____ day of _____ 2009.

Background

- A Wellington Regional Council ("Council") is a council under the Local Government Act 2002 and is authorised to enter into deeds.
- B Council wishes to grant to Jane Bradbury, Divisional Manager, Corporate and Strategy a Power of Attorney to sign deeds on behalf of the Council.

By this Deed

1. Wellington Regional Council hereby appoints Jane Bradbury of Raumati, Divisional Manager, Corporate and Strategy ("the Attorney") to be the Council's attorney to do the following on the Council's behalf:
 - (a) To sign documents by way of deeds all documents which the Council is authorised to sign, and
 - (b) To continue to exercise the power under paragraph (a) until such time as the Attorney receives notice in writing from the Council revoking this Power of Attorney.
2. Council covenants to rectify any agreement or obligation assumed by the Attorney under any deed signed by the Attorney pursuant to or under this Power of Attorney, and to ratify any act, agreement or obligation assumed by the Attorney and necessary to render the foregoing effectual.
