**Statement from Paekakiriki Community Board**

1. The board look to the Regional Council to ensure that its contracts with contracting service providers include a requirement that the contractor adopts "good employer" practices. Councils are required to be good employers and by extension Councils have a responsibility to require this of their service providers.
2. If this had been already in place, Mana Bus Services would have been prevented from adopting discriminatory policies over the use of the English language which conflict with the Human Rights Act.
