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Committee CDEM Group
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Controller and Recovery Manager Training

1. Purpose

To update the Group on the Controller and Recovery Manager training and development programme, including the attendance of appointed members.

2. Background

At the CDEM Group meeting of 6 November 2008 a progress report was tabled regarding the first two courses in the training and development programme for the CDEM Group's Controllers and Recovery Managers. Since then another two courses have been delivered. The course dates and content for each were as follows:

- **June 2008 - Course 1:**
CDEM structure, 4Rs (reduction of risks, readiness, response and recovery), six critical needs (urban search and rescue, treatment and movement of the injured, welfare arrangements, medical/health arrangements, sanitation and the restoration of lifeline services), legislation / CDEM Act, CDEM plans (group, national, local), operation of Emergency Operations Centres, Co-ordinated Incident Management System (CIMS)
- **August 2008 – Course 2:**
Declarations, powers of controllers, incident management team, functions, roles and responsibilities of controllers and recovery managers
- **June 2009 – Course 3:**
Role of elected members (local & central government), health and safety during emergencies, Lifelines arrangements, public information management, linkages to other agencies (MCDEM etc), multi – agencies (roles and responsibilities)
- **August 2009- Course 4:**
Crisis management & decision making, information analysis, short and long term planning, stress management and transition to recovery.

3. Course Attendees

The attendance of our appointed Controllers and Recovery Manager's has been inconsistent. Prior engagements and workload have lead to courses being missed. Inconsistent attendance also has made it difficult for the training and development group to achieve their goal of all Controllers and Recovery Managers working and growing together. The chart below shows the attendee, territory, designation, when appointed in the specific role and courses attended.

3.1 **Pathway forward**

In June 2010 our Controllers and Recovery Managers will be subjected to a practical exercise applying the knowledge and skills that they have obtained from the first four courses.

Feedback from attendees has proved that the courses delivered so far have been effective. The Controllers and Recovery Managers have also indicated that the training and development programme should continue. Attendees have been asked to provide ideas / topics for future courses.

The training and development group is already in the process of developing another two-year programme. A report in this regard will be tabled at the next CEG meeting in April 2010.

4. **Conclusion**

The CDEM Group Controllers and Recovery Managers' courses provided attendees the opportunity to obtain the required knowledge and skills to effectively fulfil their roles.

Opportunities to practice their skills, build relationships and networks and gain a common understanding of their roles and responsibilities were ample. The training is invaluable to our region and should continue. These courses seem to enable the CDEM Group to meet its own requirements for qualified staff.
