Report on the Social and Cultural Wellbeing Committee meeting 22 May 2013

1. Purpose

To inform the Council about the meeting of the Social and Cultural Wellbeing Committee that took place on 22 May 2013.

3. Report

3.1 General Manager's report

In what was a very brief meeting, the Committee noted that water supply demand, at 128MLD, continues to be slightly below average for this time of year.

The internal debrief on the 2013 summer water supply situation has been undertaken. A debrief meeting with external stakeholders is scheduled for 31May, after which the findings will be discussed at a Council workshop in June.

The recent public open day at the Te Marua Water Treatment Plant received very positive feedback from the 230 people who toured the plant. Given the strong level of interest, a further open day is being arranged; this is likely to occur at the Wainuiomata Water Treatment Plant during spring. Councillors suggested that a similar tour would be informative for the region's territorial authority representatives.
