Appointment of a non-Councillor member to the Wairarapa Committee</i> | <i>The information contained in this report relates to the proposed appointment of a non-Councillor member to the Wairarapa Committee. Release of this information would prejudice the proposed non-Councillor member's' privacy by disclosing the fact that they have been nominated, and have expressed interest in, becoming a member of the Committee. Greater Wellington Regional Council has not been able to identify a public interest favouring disclosure of this particular information in public proceedings of the meeting that would override the privacy of the individual concerned.</i> | <i>That the public conduct of the whole or the relevant part of the proceedings of the meeting would be likely to result in the disclosure of information for which good reason for withholding would exist under section 7(2)(a) of the Act (i.e to protect the privacy of natural persons).</i> |
