**Proposed Change 1 to the Greater Wellington Regional Policy Statement – Hearing Stream 7: Definitions (Regionally Significant Infrastructure)**

Incite have been engaged by Chorus New Zealand Limited (Chorus), Spark New Zealand Trading Limited (Spark) and One New Zealand Limited (One NZ, formerly Vodafone New Zealand Limited) in regard to their submissions on Proposed Change 1 to the Greater Wellington Regional Policy Statement.

Chorus, Spark and One NZ have one submission point (S49.008) relevant to Hearing Stream 7, which was to support the definition of *Regionally Significant infrastructure* as notified.

The relevant Section 42A Report and recommendation recommends that the submission point be accepted in part. This is due to a tweak to the definition of *Regionally Significant infrastructure* relating to Wellington International Airport Limited's infrastructure. There are no proposed changes as to how telecommunication and radiocommunication infrastructure is recognised in the definition when compared to the definition as notified.

As such, Chorus, Spark and One NZ accept the officers recommendation at Paragraph 115 of their Section 42A Report.

I have no further comment to make on Hearing Stream 7, however I am available to answer any queries or questions either in writing or via a videoconference that the Hearing Panel may have, should the Hearing Panel not agree with the recommendation made by the Council Officer.
