**MINUTE OF THE ENVIRONMENT COURT
(28 JULY 2021)**

[1] I refer to the memorandum from counsel for the Regional Council of 14 June 2021 regarding hearing time required.

[2] The Court can accommodate hearings on the above matters at any time during the weeks of 20, 27 September and 26 October 2021. There is presently a high degree of flexibility for hearing time in November and December. It may be appropriate to split hearing time into blocks to allow counsel, witnesses and the Court some breathing space and to pursue matters that may emerge during the hearing as resolvable by discussion.

[3] The Court requests counsel for the Regional Council to liaise with other counsel to ascertain what mutually agreeable dates might be agreed upon and also what expert conferencing ought be scheduled. Counsel is requested to file and serve a memorandum on those issues as soon as practicable.



[4] If it would assist the parties, a judicial conference to discuss any contentious issues, resolve management issues or make further directions can be convened at short notice. Any party may request accordingly
