We believe that Greater Wellington Regional Council's consultation was misleading in terms of caselaw and our written submission on the Draft Proposed Natural Resources Plan November 2014 should be treated as a submission.

- 5. The Plan fails to acknowledge the continual long term on-farm planting work, including a 15HA QE11 covenant, nor the prohibitive cost of stock exclusion on this type of property.
- 6. We are interested in all of the proceedings

We especially oppose Landuse Rules 95-101 constraining Vegetation Removal, Earthworks and Livestock Grazing since over time these will force us to abandon livestock farming and amount to a substantial deprivation of our property rights in terms of the Supreme Court decision in *Waitakere City Council* v *Estate Homes Ltd* [2007] NZLR 149 at para 44 and following
