**TIMEFRAMES FOR RESPONSES TO THE INDEPENDENT REVIEW OF  
OBJECTIVES REPORT FOR HEARING STREAM 3 AND THE REMAINING  
HEARING STREAMS 4 - 6**

**Introduction**

1. Following the receipt of the independent integration review report of the objectives of the PNRP on 14 July 2017 and the email from the Hearing Officer to all parties advising that Hearing Stream 3 is now scheduled to begin on Monday 4 September 2017; this has led to a need for the Panel to update the timeframes set out in Minute 13 for comments on the integration review report from submitters and Section 42A Reporting officers in relation to Hearing Stream 3 and the remaining Hearing Streams 4 - 6.

**Hearing Stream 3**

2. The timetable for all parties' responses to the integration review report for Hearing Stream 3, as set out in Minute 13 are rescinded.
3. The timetable for all parties' responses to the integration review report for Hearing Stream 3, are as follows:
  - a. Hearing Stream 3 is due to commence on 4 September 2017. The Section 42A reports for Hearing Stream 3 are due to be pre-circulated on 7 August 2017. Submitter expert evidence reports for Hearing Stream 3 are due to be pre-circulated on 21 August 2017.
  - b. The integration review report has been completed at 14 July 2017.
  - c. Any submitter that wishes to provide comment on the integration review report as it relates to Hearing Stream 3 may do so in writing and this should be tabled and

presented to the Panel at the submitters scheduled appearance during the course of Hearing Stream 3.

- d. The Section 42A officers should address any issues from the integration review report my way of a written addendum to their Section 42A report which should be available for pre-circulation on 21 August 2017.
- e. The Section 42A Reporting Officers for Hearing Stream 3 can address any further matters raised by submitters in their reply statements.

#### **Hearing Streams 4 - 6**

- 4. For all consequential hearing streams, including the Wetlands and Indigenous Biodiversity topic which has been moved from Hearing Stream 3 to Hearing Stream 5, Reporting Officers and submitters may address matters related to the integration review report in the relevant Section 42A report and hearing evidence.
