Amendment of Proposed Natural Resources Plan pursuant to clause 16 of Schedule 1 to the Resource Management Act 1991

Clause 16 of Schedule 1 to the Resource Management Act 1991 provides for the Wellington Regional Council to make amendments to the Proposed Natural Resources Plan, without using the process set out in Schedule 1, to alter any information, where such an alteration is of minor effect, or to correct any minor errors.

The Manager, Environmental Policy, Wellington Regional Council, has considered the relevant provisions in Appendix 1 against those tests (alteration of minor effect or corrections of a minor error) and acting under authority delegated by the Wellington Regional Council, has decided the amendments to the Proposed Natural Resources Plan as set out in Appendix 1 meet those tests and are made accordingly.

There were previous amendments made under clause 16 of Schedule 1 to the Resource Management Act 1991 to the Proposed Natural Resources Plan (see memo dated 19 November 2019). The amendments now approved are in addition to those amendments, but Appendix 1 contains the current list of amendments being made and Appendix 2 includes the 2019 list of amendments already made, for ease of reference.

**APPENDIX 1 - CLAUSE 16 AMENDMENTS TO THE PROPOSED NATURAL RESOURCES PLAN FOR THE WELLINGTON REGION
(APPEALS VERSION FINAL 2022) – 24 August 2022**

16 Amendment of proposed policy statement or plan

- (1) A local authority must, without using the process in this schedule, make an amendment to its proposed policy statement or plan that is required by [section 55\(2\)](#) or by a direction of the Environment Court under [section 293](#).
- (2) A local authority may make an amendment, without using the process in this schedule, to its proposed policy statement or plan to alter any information, where such an alteration is of minor effect, or may correct any minor errors.

The clause 16 amendments as listed in the schedule below have been made by the Wellington Regional Council to the Proposed Natural Resources Plan, Decisions Version and are shown as black track/~~strike through~~ changes. The Council is satisfied that in relation to each of these changes, they meet the requirements of clause 16 – i.e., it is an alteration of minor effect, or it is an alteration necessary to correct a minor error.

Note, the numbering below refers to the provision number BEFORE the renumbering of the provisions occurred (see the cross-reference table to show what provision numbers referred to below are in the renumbered version of the Plan).
