1. **Wairarapa Water User's Incorporated Society (WWU)** wishes to become a party to the appeal by Wellington Water Limited against the decisions made by Greater Wellington Regional Council (GWRC) on the Proposed Natural Resources Plan.
2. WWU made a submission and further submissions on the matters included in this appeal and has an interest greater than the public generally.
3. WWU is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991.
4. WWU is interested in part of the matters appealed by Wellington Water Limited.
5. In particular, WWU is interested in the following issues:
 - Policy P111: Water takes at minimum flows and minimum water levels;
 - Policy P115: Authorising takes below minimum flows and lake levels; and
 - Policy P118: Reasonable and efficient use.
6. WWU supports part of the relief sought insofar that it is consistent with WWU's appeal on the basis that the relief sought:
 - a. Requests the deletion of the requirement for industrial uses to cease after seven years;
 - b. Retain water allocation amounts that are approved under existing consents;
 - c. Ensures that Policy P118 applies in an appropriate way to municipal water supply networks.
7. WWU agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
