1. Wellington Water Limited (**WWL**) is an appellant (ENV-2019-WGN-123) and a s 274 party to twenty-one other appeals.
2. WWL considers the grouping of appeals by subject matter, and the general approach towards discussions and mediation, as recorded in GWRC's case management memorandum (8 November 2019), is appropriate.
