

Notice of Wellington Water Limited's wish to be party to proceedings

1. Wellington Water Limited (**WWL**) wishes to be a party to the following appeal of decisions on the Proposed Natural Resources Plan for the Wellington Region:

Centreport v Wellington Regional Council, ENV-2019-WLG-000118

2. WWL is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991.
3. WWL agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
4. WWL is interested in the part of the proceedings related to:

Policy P40 - Ecosystems and habitats with significant indigenous biodiversity values

5. WWL supports the relief sought in relation to this part because it better recognises the benefits of regionally significant infrastructure.
6. WWL is interested in the part of the proceedings related to:

Rules R202, R203 and new rule - Dredging

7. WWL opposes the relief sought in relation to this part. The relief sought in regards to the new rule proposed to be included will not protect the aquifer from potential contamination, and will therefore not achieve Objective O6 or O23 of the Plan.
8. WWL made submissions on Policy P40; and has an interest in the parts of the proceedings identified in this notice that is greater than the interest that the general public has, because those parts relate to provisions that affect water infrastructure and services, for which WWL is responsible.
